

Staff Exchange Programme 2019/2020

The ETC Staff Exchange Programme offers all technical, administrative and artistic personnel from Member Theatres the opportunity to visit another theatre in the network for up to 30 days. They will be able to exchange know-how and professional techniques with their European colleagues while experiencing the theatre sector of another European country.

The programme encourages the sharing of best practice, peer-learning and on-the-job training as well as the development of personal, professional and intercultural skills. Spread the word among your staff members and encourage them to experience the diversity of Europe's theatre scene!

The Staff Exchange Programme is part of "ENGAGE - Empowering today's audiences through challenging theatre", co-funded by the Creative Europe Programme of the European Union.

Grants for ETC Members:

The grant is paid out to the sending theatre and consists of the following:

- a contribution to local expenses (€20/day, max. 30 days)
- a contribution to travel costs of up to €300

We have 5 grants available for ETC Member Theatres to send a staff member to a fellow ETC Member Theatre for up to 30 days. Grants include travel costs (up to €300) and subsistence costs. The accommodation is organised and paid for by the receiving theatre. The grants are awarded based on the decisions of the ETC Board. Applications are to be completed by the sending theatre and staff member.

Applications are now open for the Staff Exchange Programme 2019/2020.
